

PersonalBest/Responsible Citizen: Students in my Kindergarten class are recognized monthly for achievement in these two areas.



Dressing for School: Please dress your child in comfortable clothing for school.



Birthdays: Children may celebrate their birthdays in school. A special treat may be sent in.



Field Trips: Kindergarten goes on two field trips a year - fall/spring.



Big Buddies: Periodically through-out the school year we meet with 5th grade buddies. The kindergartners look up to their older buddy for guidance.



Book Orders: Periodically you will have the opportunity to order from Scholastic Book Clubs.



Classroom Volunteers: Parents and/or Adults are welcome to volunteer in the classroom. A background check is mandatory for all volunteers. Kindergarten Class Rules:

Marble Jar Reward: A marble is placed in the marble jar every time the whole class does their personal best.



Warm and Fuzzies: A warm and fuzzie (pom pomvarious size and color) is given to a child when they are caught portraying <u>model behavior</u>.



Gold Coins: A gold is given to a child when they are noticed for doing their personal best <u>academically</u>.



Clip it! Behavior Chart: A five color behavior chart hangs in the room with each child's name clip clipped to it. Everyone begins the day on Green and their name clip may move up or down the chart according to their behavior choices for the day.



Prize Pail: At the end of each day one random child's name is drawn to pick a pencil or eraser. This child has to have been on green or blue all day in order to be eligible.
